

Install and authenticate Adobe Digital Editions

INSTALLATION

The steps to follow to install Adobe® Digital Editions (ADE) are as follows:

- 1. **Click on this link:** <http://www.adobe.com/es/products/digital-editions/download.html>.
- 2. In order to download the application, you need to choose your **Operating System**.
- 3. Once downloaded, find the file and double click on it. A setup window will show up. Click on **Execute**.
- 4. The **License Agreement** will show up. Click on **I agree on the terms and conditions** and then click **Next**.
- 5. On the next screen, select the shortcuts you wish to install on your computer. Click on **Next**.
- 6. On the next screen, select the location on your computer where you want to have ADE installed (you can leave the default). After selecting, click on the **Install button**.
- 7. After this, the ADE setup process will start. After completion, click on the **Close** button.
- 8. A new pop-up window will open showing the installation has been successful.
- 9. ADE will open.

ADE AUTHENTICATION USING ODILO VENDOR ID

The steps you need to follow to authenticate with Adobe Digital Editions and synchronize several devices at the same time with your library card id are as follows:

- 1. **Open** Adobe Digital Editions.
- 2. Go to **Help > Authorize device...**
3. In the form **Authorize device...:**
 - a. On the Provider drop-down menu, please select **Odilo**.
 - a. On the Provider ID text input field, please type your **library card number**.
 - b. In the Password section, type your **library password** to access the platform.
- 4. Click on the **Authorize** button.
 5. Repeat the same steps on any device where you want to read your books with ADE.
- 6. There are several devices that, due to limitations from the manufacturer, do not allow authorization with the credentials to log in with library ID. For these devices, it is necessary to have an Adobe account (Adobe ID) and authorize the device with these credentials.

NOTE ON DRM PROTECTION

1: Any eBook that has been read or downloaded **PRIOR TO** an Adobe ID's activation, will stop working after our **ODILO** Adobe ID has been activated.

2: Any eBook that has been read or downloaded with a **DIFFERENT** Adobe ID, will stop working with an **ODILO** Adobe ID.
